1 OFFICER: Get in the car young lady. Have a seat?

2 DEFENDANT: Can I ask one question?

3 OFFICER: Sure.

4 DEFENDANT: My car.

5 OFFICER: We'll take care of it. It is not driveable
6 right now anywhere.

7 DEFENDANT: Well, obviously, because my mother and
8 brother are away.

9 OFFICER: It is not driveable. In other words even if
10 they wanted to drive it they can't get it anywhere.

11 DEFENDANT: All right.

12 OFFICER: Okay.

13 DEFENDANT: All right.

14 **DIALOGUE BETWEEN OFFICERS**

15 Q. (Unintelligible) we have got a 17. The problem is
16 this --

17 A. (Unintelligible).

18 Q. Well, I mean it is such a double edged sword?

19 A. I don't think you will have a problem with that at
20 all.

21 Q. It is such a double edged sword, because you are at a
22 traffic light and the traffic light goes green and people start
23 to accelerate.

24 A. There you go.

25 Q. And there is no reason in your head whether you keep a

1 safe distance or not, you would be anticipating someone to
2 abruptly slam on the brakes unless you see a large object coming
3 and especially -- as far as I am concerned I am going to put
4 words in his mouth. She went to accelerate a cat jumped out,
5 literally a cat jumped out the window at which time as he
6 thought --

7 A. (Laughing).

8 Q. -- could have been a pedestrian, which distracted him
9 because he was concerned and that's normal. And before he comes
10 to a stop, boom. Hey.

11 A. (Unintelligible).

12 Q. Actually, I mean I wouldn't expect a cat to come out.
13 I mean it could have been a fucking kid jump out the fucking
14 window.

15 A. That's exactly what I thought. I didn't know what the
16 fuck was going on.

17 Q. I ain't worried about the accident shit right now.
18 Let me get her a blow and get her sample. I know they are on
19 video. I hung her up to dry on that. She gets to the stop
20 light I mean she is telling me, well, she abruptly slams on the
21 brakes, blah, blah, blah.

22 So I ain't too worried about that. I mean what's the
23 chance of hitting a fucking drunk with a cat jumping out the
24 window. I think they should hold stars for her and I, that's
25 funny. (Unintelligible) only motherfucker --

1 A. (Unintelligible).

2 Q. Tell him I will take care of the narrative and the
3 crash report and give it to him or email it.

4 A. When you are done let me see.

5 Q. What?

6 A. When you are done let me see. This was in here close
7 up. The (unintelligible) I don't know if that's
8 (unintelligible).

9 Q. Yes. I already have her on video. She said she has
10 been doing a beer party, so. (Unintelligible).

11 A. I don't know if she is diabetic or not, but I don't
12 see no needles.

13 Q. No, I have her on camera, afterwards I don't give a
14 shit.

15 A. She is fucking --

16 Q. Yes, she is a trip.

17 A. (Unintelligible)

18 Q. Fuck, yeah, man. You know (unintelligible) right now
19 or you got it in already?

20 A. I got it.

21 Q. Yes. Just let me space the whole thing out. I will
22 do the narrative for you. I know how I am going to word this,
23 the cat gets him off the hook.

24 A. (Unintelligible).

25 Q. I will write the narrative out for you. I will tell

1 you exactly how to word it so it can get him off the hook.

2 A. Okay. (Unintelligible) tickets.

3 Q. Well, I am not going to give her any tickets because
4 even though she is going to get a DUI ticket, as far as like I
5 can't charge her DUI property damage because the accident
6 (unintelligible). So don't worry about any citations at all.

7 A. That will be all right. (Unintelligible).

8 Q. Nah.

9 A. Only you mother-fucker.

10 Q. Kareem, come here, man.

11 A. (Unintelligible).

12 Q. I am going to show you something. We are going to
13 bend this a little bit.

14 A. Okay.

15 Q. Because she is drunk so it is what it is.

16 A. Hey, You are the expert.

17 Q. Well, I don't want to make things up ever, because
18 it's wrong, but if I need to bend it a little bit to protect a
19 cop I'm gonna. You see the angle of her car --

20 A. Yes.

21 Q. You see where it's like this?

22 A. Yes.

23 Q. As far as I am concerned I am going to word it she is
24 in the left hand lane.

25 A. Okay.

1 Q. And when the cat jumped out she abruptly got over to
2 this lane and slammed on the brakes.

3 A. Okay.

4 Q. Because of the angle of the crash his is over here
5 hers is on that side and the angle of the crash.

6 A. That's fine.

7 Q. I will make sure Andre gets -- you know what I'm
8 saying.

9 A. That's fine.

10 Q. Andre. (Unintelligible) Andre, come here a minute.
11 We'll do a little Walt Disney to protect the cop because it
12 wouldn't have matter because she is drunk anyway. You see the
13 angle of her car? You see where the collision is?

14 A. Okay.

15 Q. You have already taken photographs yes or no?

16 A. Yes.

17 Q. Well, is there any way -- this is what I want to
18 articulate that she was in this lane and cut over to this lane.
19 It was at the angle what I tried to do with my head on camera is
20 follow the cat. If the cat were to jump you could get to her
21 exactly. That's what I want.

22 A. (Unintelligible).

23 Q. You don't have to get any pictures I need or any
24 whatever, because I don't want Joe to get any (unintelligible).
25 That's not fair to him. She is freaking hammered anyway.

1 A. No problem.

2 Q. What's your badge again?

3 A. (Unintelligible).

4 Q. We are always on the same page, that's why we get
5 along so well.

6 A. That's what I thought. That was my first thought too.
7 Because when I talked to them I said, okay, now she was in this
8 lane, right. I have done plenty accidents from right here where
9 this person goes over.

10 Q. We are good. We are good.

11 OFFICER: All right, young lady you are okay?

12 DEFENDANT: It depends?

13 OFFICER: Okay.

14 DEFENDANT: Is somebody going to Drive my car.

15 OFFICER: We are going to get a tow truck. The back
16 end the tire is bent.

17 DEFENDANT: Excuse me.

18 OFFICER: The back tire the wheel is bent. It can't
19 be driven. Don't worry about the car. We should take care
20 of it for you.

21 DEFENDANT: I guess.

22 OFFICER: No I am telling you, ma'am, I am not making
23 you --

24 DEFENDANT: Was my car searched.

25 OFFICER: Searched why? What do you mean searched?

1 DEFENDANT: To make sure the paperwork was up to
2 work.

3 OFFICER: Yes, I have your wallet and stuff, which
4 goes with you into your other property.

5 DEFENDANT: Uh-huh.

6 OFFICER: I can't talk right now. I will call you in
7 a minute.

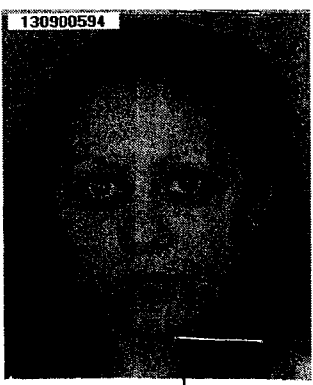

PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

Before me this date personally appeared PRESSLEY, DEWEY who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on 17 day of February, 2009 at 2800 SHERIDAN ST (crime location) the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe same are as follows:

ON 02/17/09 AT OR ABOUT 00:09 HOURS AT THE LOCATION OF 2800 SHERIDAN ST, WHICH IS LOCATED WITHIN THE JURISDICTIONAL LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, WITHIN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA, THE ABOVE NAMED DEFENDANT DID COMMIT THE VIOLATION OF DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE. ALEXANDRA GABRIELA TORRENS DID THEN AND THERE UNLAWFULLY DRIVE, OR WAS IN ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL OF A MOTOR VEHICLE, TO-WIT: 1997 TOYOTA TERCEL, 2DOOR, RED IN COLOR, BEARING FLORIDA TAG #330-HQR, WHILE SHE WAS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE TO THE EXTENT THAT HER NORMAL FACULTIES WERE IMPAIRED, OR WITH A BLOOD ALCOHOL LEVEL OF 0.08 PERCENT, TO-WIT; 0.153 PERCENT @ 00:48 HRS AND 0.152 PERCENT @ 00:51 HRS.

THE UNDERSIGNED, WHO IS ASSIGNED TO THE DUI TASK FORCE RESPONDED TO THE ABOVE LOCATION REFERENCE TO A TRAFFIC CRASH WHICH HAD OCCURRED INVOLVING A CITY OF HOLLYWOOD POLICE VEHICLE AND A POSSIBLY IMPAIRED DRIVER. THIS POLICE VEHICLE IS NOTED TO BE A 2004 FORD CROWN VICTORIA #2817, WITH A VIN# 2FAF171W94X106428. IT HAD ALSO OBTAINED APPROXIMATELY \$3000.00 IN DAMAGES DUE TO THIS TRAFFIC CRASH. UPON ARRIVAL, CONTACT WAS MADE WITH OFFICER FRANCISCO #2657, WHO WAS OPERATING THE MARKED HOLLYWOOD POLICE UNIT #2817. OFFICER FRANCISCO ADVISED THAT HE HAD BEEN STOPPED FOR THE RED LIGHT IN THE 2800 BLOCK OF SHERIDAN ST OCCUPYING THE CENTER WESTBOUND LANE. THE TRAFFIC LIGHT HAD CHANGED TO GREEN AND AS HE BEGAN ACCELERATING HE OBSERVED TO HIS LEFT A RED OLDER MODEL TOYOTA, WHICH WAS ALSO TRAVELING WESTBOUND. APPROXIMATELY 50 FEET INTO THE INTERSECTION, OFFICER FRANCISCO OBSERVED A LARGE OBJECT DARK GRAY IN COLOR TO HAVE BECOME EJECTED OUT OF THE DRIVER'S FRONT WINDOW OF THIS RED TOYOTA. THIS RED TOYOTA WITHOUT ANY WARNING CHANGED ITS COURSE OF TRAVEL INTO THE CENTER LANE WHICH OFFICER FRANCISCO WAS OCCUPYING. THIS VEHICLE ABRUPTLY APPLIED ITS BRAKES AND CAME TO A COMPLETE STOP IN FRONT OF OFFICER FRANCISCO LEAVING HIM NO COURSE OF ACTION BUT TO STRIKE THE RIGHT REAR OF THE RED TOYOTA WITH THE LEFT FRONT OF HIS POLICE VEHICLE. THIS OFFICER ASSISTING IN THIS TRAFFIC CRASH INVESTIGATION DID OBSERVE PHYSICAL EVIDENCE PRESENT. THIS EVIDENCE SHOWED THE PATH OF TRAVEL AND THE ANGLE OF IMPACT OF THESE TWO VEHICLES.

AFTER THE TRAFFIC CRASH HAD OCCURRED OFFICER FRANCISCO IMMEDIATELY EXITED HIS VEHICLE TO CHECK ON THE OTHER DRIVER. UPON DOING SO, HE OBSERVED A W/F THAT WAS SEATED BEHIND THE STEERING WHEEL, BEING THE SOLE OCCUPANT IN THIS VEHICLE. THIS DRIVER IS NOTED TO BE THE ARRESTEE WHO IS ALSO LISTED AS V-1 IN THE TRAFFIC CRASH REPORT. OFFICER FRANCISCO STATED THAT THE ARRESTEE TORRENS MADE A SPONTANEOUS STATEMENT THAT "IT JUST JUMPED OUT", AT WHICH TIME HE QUESTIONED WHAT HAD JUMPED OUT. THE ARRESTEE STATED "A LARGE GRAY STRAY CAT", WHICH HAD BEEN SITTING ON THE ARRESTEE'S LAP WHILE SHE WAS OPERATING THIS VEHICLE. WITHOUT ANY INDICATION THIS CAT HAD JUMPED OFF OF THE ARRESTEE'S LAP AND OUT OF THIS VEHICLE THROUGH THE OPEN DRIVER'S WINDOW WHILE THIS VEHICLE WAS IN TRANSIT. THIS HAD DISTRACTED THE ARRESTEE, CAUSING HER TO LOOK BACK TOWARDS HER LEFT AND THE ARRESTEE STEERED THIS VEHICLE RIGHT INTO OFFICER FRANCISCO'S PATH OF TRAVEL.

OFFICER FRANCISCO WHILE CONVERSING WITH THE ARRESTEE SMELLED A STRONG ODOR OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE EMANATING FROM HER BREATH. THE ARRESTEE'S EYES WERE RED, WATERY AND GLASSY. THE ARRESTEE'S SPEECH WAS SLIGHTLY SLURRED AT TIMES AND LOW IN VOLUME. UPON THIS OFFICER MAKING CONTACT WITH THE ARRESTEE, SHE WAS STILL SEATED IN THE DRIVER'S SEAT OF HER VEHICLE. I IDENTIFIED MYSELF AS OFFICER PRESSLEY, WHO WAS THERE TO CONDUCT A CRIMINAL DUI INVESTIGATION. I THEN MADE IT CLEAR TO THE ARRESTEE THAT THERE WERE TWO SITUATIONS THAT WERE OCCURRING. ONE, THAT THERE WAS A TRAFFIC CRASH INVESTIGATION WHICH WAS BEING CONDUCTED BY CSO THOMAS #2932. THE OTHER WAS A CRIMINAL DUI INVESTIGATION WHICH I WAS THERE TO CONDUCT TO DETERMINE IF SHE WAS DRIVING IMPAIRED.

I ASKED THE ARRESTEE IF SHE WAS HAVING MECHANICAL PROBLEMS WITH HER VEHICLE PRIOR TO THIS CRASH. THE ARRESTEE ANSWERED "NO". I THEN ASKED THE ARRESTEE IF SHE WAS HAVING ANY MEDICAL ISSUES PRIOR TO OR DUE TO THIS CRASH AND THE ARRESTEE ANSWERED "NO". PRIOR TO ANY OTHER QUESTIONS BEING ASKED OF THE ARRESTEE I READ THE MIRANDA RIGHTS TO THE ARRESTEE FROM A PREPARED TEXT DUE TO THE FLORIDA TRAFFIC CRASH PRIVILEGE. I THEN ASKED THE ARRESTEE IF SHE WISHED TO SPEAK TO THIS OFFICER ABOUT THIS CRASH AND THE ARRESTEE ANSWERED "YES".

THIS OFFICER MADE A REQUEST OF THE ARRESTEE TO PERFORM SOME VOLUNTARY ROADSIDE EXERCISES TO DETERMINE IF SHE WAS DRIVING WHILE IMPAIRED. THE ARRESTEE STATED SHE WOULD COMPLY AND THE FOLLOWING OBSERVATIONS WERE NOTED.

HGN - 4 CLUES:

- * BOTH EYES COULD NOT SMOOTHLY FOLLOW A MOVING OBJECT
- * BOTH EYES HAD DISTINCT NYSTAGMUS AT MAXIMUM DEVIATION

WALK AND TURN - 6 CLUES:

- * THE ARRESTEE STOPPED/PAUSED SEVERAL SECONDS WHILE WALKING AND FAILED TO TOUCH HEEL TO TOE, LEAVING APPROXIMATELY 10"-12" SPACE BETWEEN EACH STEP.
- * THE ARRESTEE ALSO STEPPED OFF THE LINE ONE OR TWO MORE TIMES ON THE UPWARD AND RETURN COUNT, ACTUALLY RAISING HER HANDS FOR BALANCING ISSUES AS IF SHE WAS WALKING ON AN ACTUAL TIGHTROPE.
- * ARRESTEE DID NOT TURN CORRECTLY, AS DEMONSTRATED DOING AN ABOUT FACE WHILE DRAGGING HER RIGHT FOOT, ALMOST FALLING DOWN. THE ARRESTEE ALSO TOOK 9 STEPS ON THE UPWARD COUNT, BUT TOOK 13 STEPS ON THE RETURN COUNT. THE ARRESTEE ALSO FAILED TO COUNT THE STEPS OUT LOUD ON THE RETURN COUNT.

IT SHOULD ALSO BE NOTED THAT THE ARRESTEE INFORMED THIS OFFICER THAT SHE HAS BEEN TRAINING IN THE DANCE OF BALLET FOR THE PAST 11 YEARS. I ASKED THE ARRESTEE THAT IF THAT WERE TO BE TRUE THAT SHE SHOULD HAVE ABOVE AVERAGE MUSCLE TONE AND CONTROL. THE ARRESTEE ANSWERED "YES".

ONE LEG STAND - 5 CLUES:

ARRESTEE COULD NOT DO THIS TEST, AFTER THREE ATTEMPTS SHE HAD PUT HER FOOT DOWN AND ALMOST FELL OVER, THIS OFFICER HAD TO CATCH THE ARRESTEE TO PREVENT HER FROM BEING INJURED.

FINGER TO NOSE - 3 CLUES:

* THE ARRESTEE MISSED THE TIP OF HER NOSE WITH HER INDEX FINGER COMING IN FROM THE SIDE TOUCHING THE BRIDGE OF HER NOSE WITH THE PAD OF HER FINGER AND THE SIDE OF HER NOSE WITH THE TIP OF HER FINGER. FURTHERMORE, THE ARRESTEE FORGOT TO REMOVE HER FINGER FROM HER FACIAL AREA AFTER EACH COMMAND, WHICH HAD BEEN EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO THE ARRESTEE BY THIS OFFICER PRIOR TO THIS EXERCISE. THE ARRESTEE WAS SWAYING 2"-3" COUNTER CLOCKWISE DURING THIS ENTIRE EXERCISE.

RHOMBERG BALANCE - 2 CLUES:

* ARRESTEE CONTINUED TO SWAY FORWARD AND BACKWARDS 2"-3" AND BEGAN HAVING EYELID TREMORS AT 50 SECONDS INTO THIS EXERCISE. THE ARRESTEE ESTIMATED THE 30 SECONDS AS ACTUALLY 1 MINUTE AND 5 SECONDS. THE ARRESTEE MADE THE SPONTANEOUS STATEMENT THAT SHE WAS DONE AND SHE HAD COUNTED TO 35.

THIS OFFICER SEEING THE POOR OUTCOME OF THE EXERCISE'S , PLACED THE ARRESTEE INTO CUSTODY FOR THE OFFENSE OF DUI. THIS OFFICER MADE A REQUEST OF THE ARRESTEE TO PROVIDE A BREATH SAMPLE VIA FLORIDA LAW AT WHICH TIME THE ARRESTEE STATED SHE WOULD COMPLY.

THIS OFFICER TRANSPORTED THE ARRESTEE TO THE HOLLYWOOD POLICE DETENTION FACILITY FOR PROCESSING AND ONCE AT THE DETENTION FACILITY, I CONDUCTED A 20-MINUTE OBSERVATION, WHICH STARTED AT 00:23 HRS AND CONCLUDED AT 00:43 HRS. THIS OFFICER UTILIZED THE INTOXILIZER 8000, BEARING SERIAL #80-001063 DID OBTAINED THE TWO AFOREMENTIONED BREATH SAMPLES WITH OUT INCIDENT. THIS OFFICER WHILE ADMINISTERING THIS BREATH TEST DID OBSERVE WHAT APPEARED TO BE GREY IN COLOR CAT HAIRS AFFIXED TO THE ARRESTEE'S CLOTHING.

AT THIS TIME, THERE IS NO FURTHER INFORMATION REFERENCE TO THIS INCIDENT.
